**HAPPY NEW YEAR!**

I hope you and those you love have had a great time over the holiday period, and that this newsletter finds you still celebrating on January 1st, which is around the halfway mark of the twelve days of Christmas. That's nearly two weeks of feasting, which is enough to distract anybody from their new year's resolutions. If we've done our celebrating as thoroughly as our medieval forbears, we ought to feel thoroughly done with Christmas's excess by the time we reach Twelfth Night, or the 5th of January.

The last gasp of Christmas revels, Twelfth Night has traditionally been a night of wild merriment. One of the loveliest traditions is eating a King Cake with a small token or favour hidden inside, and crowning whoever finds it King or Queen for

the evening. This is of course related to the celebration of the feast of the Epiphany the next day, January 6th, which is when the church remembers the visit of the three kings to the newly-born Christ child.

Wassailing is a big part of the English tradition of Twelfth Night and Epiphany-tide. In this earliest part of the year, the Anglo-Saxons sang to their apple trees to remind them to flower and fruit again in the following spring and summer, and the tradition developed into singing carols around villages in return for food and drink. I'm delighted to say that we'll be doing our own wassailing in Wootton on January 6th, with musical help from Ann and Mel Leggett. We will meet at 6pm in the community orchard, and make our way through the village, singing (and drinking cider) until we get to the Rectory for apple cake. It will all finish up at 9pm at the latest. Do join in; it promises to be a good way to ring in the new year. No experience necessary: just a willingness to drink cider.

Finally, the start of the year is also a lovely time to have a house blessing: don't hesitate to get in touch if you'd like one. May 2026 bring you, and all whom you love, much joy.

# GREEN FINGERS



January out of all the months in the Gardening calendar does seem to be the hardest to find a plant to tempt you in to trying – especially in my first ever Plant of the month article! However, like all Gardeners I like a challenge and I've chosen one that you don't see all that often. Iris unguicularis or commonly known as the Algerian Iris. Growing conditions: Full sun or next to a warm wall/fence. Well drained soil.



Propagation: Division. It has all the hallmarks of the other great iris's you'll know but remarkably its flowering time tends to be between November-March (depending on the seasons). Deserving of this title because it produces flowers in this winter stretch but equally I'm confident they would have demanded a space in your summer flowering border too, had that been the time of year it chose to flower. They grow in clumps which can spread – Great for gardening on a budget! But do be careful about placing them next to anything delicate in the border as it can be very competitive. My Top Tip: In October /early November look for signs of the buds developing at the base of the clump –

these will appear at the base as slim but sturdy daggers. They should be easily differentiated from the leaves, partly because the leaves will be so much taller but also, they look and feel firmer. The leaves have already done a grand job in gathering energy, so this is where I implore you to grab some shears/secateurs and chop all the leaves off, being careful not to snip the buds. The result will be a mass of striking blue flowers with no messy leaves to obscure your view! Wishing you a happy new year.






